Category 1 Eligibility



Category 1 Eligibility: Definition

Any individual with a disability who is unable, as the result of a physical or mental impairment (including a vision impairment), and without the assistance of another individual (except the operator of a wheelchair lift or other boarding assistance device), to board, ride, or disembark from any vehicle on the system which is readily accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities.

[§37.123(e)(1)]

Category 1 Eligibility: Example

A person with a cognitive disability who may not be able to:

- plan the trip
- identify the correct bus number
- recognize destinations
- make transfers from one route to another.





Category 1 Eligibility: Example

A person with a visual impairment who may have difficulty traveling unfamiliar places.





Category 1 Eligibility: Example

A person with a physical limitation who cannot stand on a moving bus when all seats are taken.



Category 2 Eligibility



Category 2 Eligibility: Definition

Any individual with a disability who needs the assistance of a wheelchair lift or other boarding assistance device and is able, with such assistance, to board, ride, and disembark from any vehicle which is readily accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities if the individual wants to travel on a route of the system during the hours of operation of the system at a time, or within a reasonable period of such time, when such a vehicle is not being used to provide designated public transportation on the route. §37.123(e)(2)



Category 2 Eligibility

A rider is eligible under Category 2 for paratransit service if the fixed route they travel on is not accessible based on either the vehicle or the stops causing an issue with the vehicle's equipment.



Category 2 Eligibility: Example

A broken lift on the bus that serves a route.

Category 2 Eligibility: Example

A stop on the route creates obstacle, such as terrain or construction, which prevent the safe deployment of the bus equipment.





Category 3 Eligibility



Category 3 Eligibility: Definition

Any individual with a disability who has a specific impairmentrelated condition which prevents such individual from traveling to a boarding location or from a disembarking location on such system. §37.123(e)(3)

Category 3 Eligibility

A person is eligible for paratransit service under Category 3 when architectural or environmental factors create obstructions to accessibility.

Category 3 Eligibility: Examples

- Lack of curb ramps or reasonable alternative path of travel
- Lack of sidewalks or alternative safe accessible path of travel






Category 3 Eligibility: Examples

 Distance from the stop/station to the trip origin or destination
