

Welcome to K-TAP Unit #3: Kentucky WORKS Program. Learning objective: today, we will learn how to understand the Kentucky WORKS Program.

So, what is the Kentucky WORKS Program? The Kentucky WORKS program is available to those receiving K-TAP benefits and provides training and job-seeking assistance. The goal of the Kentucky WORKS Program is to enable work eligible individuals to support their families through self-sufficiency.

The Kentucky WORKS program provides Support services for school supplies and work-related needs, such as the cost of driver's education classes, work uniforms, school supplies, books, or software, and childcare up to the maximum amount for the geographic area.

The Kentucky WORKS Program also provides up to \$200 per month to pay for transportation costs incurred while working, participating, or preparing to participate in Kentucky WORKS program activities, and up to \$1,500 in vehicle repair expenses each 12-month period. This can include vehicle registration costs, license fees, liability insurance, vehicle property tax, repairs on the vehicle to make it functional, and other car expenses.
