

Monthly Transportation Payments

The Kentucky WORKS Program offers payments for transportation expenses while working, participating, or preparing to participate in Kentucky WORKS program activities. Payments are intended to cover transportation and travel-related expenses necessary for an individual to participate or prepare to participate in Kentucky WORKS Program activities. This can include gas, parking, tolls, ride fare, and rides to get children to child care providers.

Payment Amounts Available

Kentucky Works Program participants can receive:

\$200 per month by participating
four or more days per month

or

\$15 per month by participating
three days or less in a month

Funds are paid a month in advance. Transportation payments are made in advance of the prospective month the service will be used. Transportation payments are deposited to an **EBT account**.

Two-Member Household

If there are two individuals in the household participating in Kentucky WORKS Program activities who are requesting transportation, each has their own an EBT account and card to access their transportation payments.

If the Kentucky WORKS eligible client needs transportation to take a child to daycare in order to participate in program activities, transportation can be paid even if the participant walks to the activity.
