

Welcome to K-TAP Unit 4: Monthly Transportation Payments. Learning objective: in this unit, we will learn how to describe Kentucky WORKS Monthly Transportation Payments.

The Kentucky WORKS Program offers payments for transportation expenses while working, participating, or preparing to participate in Kentucky WORKS program activities. Payments are intended to cover transportation and travel-related expenses necessary for an individual to participate or prepare to participate in Kentucky WORKS Program activities. This can include, gas, parking, tolls, ride fare, and rides to get children to child care providers.

Kentucky Works Program participants can receive \$200 per month by participating in Kentucky WORKS Program activities for four or more days per month or \$15 per month by participating three days or less in a month.

Funds are paid a month in advance. Transportation payments are made in advance of the prospective month the service will be used. Transportation payments are deposited to an EBT account.

If there are two individuals in the household participating in Kentucky WORKS Program activities who are requesting transportation, each has their own EBT account and card to access their transportation payments.

If the Kentucky WORKS eligible client needs transportation to take a child to daycare in order to participate in program activities, transportation can be paid even if the participant walks to the activity.

Learning Stop:

Number One: If the Kentucky WORKS participant completes four or more activities per month, how much transportation assistance will they receive?

The correct answer is D. If the Kentucky WORKS participant completes four or more activities per month, they will receive \$200 in transportation assistance.

Number Two: How are transportation support payments made to Kentucky WORKS program participants?

- C. On an EBT Card
- D. Cash payments

The correct answer is C. Transportation support payments are deposited to an EBT account.

Number Three: True or False? If two members of a household are participating in Kentucky WORKS program, both may receive transportation support payments on their own EBT card.

The correct answer is True. Two members of a household participating in the program will receive support payments through their own EBT card.
