Community Integration Supplement

The Community Integration Supplement or "CIS" is one type of State Supplement Program in Kentucky. CIS was designed for Kentuckians with a mental illness who live in a private residence and have needs beyond the cost of room and board. Transportation is one example of a need that could be paid for using the Community Integration Supplement.

To qualify for CIS, you must:

Meet State Supplement Program requirements Have a verified, serious mental illness

Live or intend to live in a private residence

Have needs beyond room and board

The amount of CIS you might qualify for will vary but may be as much as \$520 per month. The amount of your Community Integration Supplement (CIS) will depend on your resources and other income you already receive.
